After working with the staff at the Mason City Workforce Center, he was able to take a job skills assessment evaluation. The staff then assisted him with developing a functional résumé and cover letter. He was also trained on how to conduct a job search using IowaJobs.org. He was contacted by a local employer through IowaJobs.org and was offered the position.
